2. IMPORTANT INFORMATION

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION

Compulsory Registration:

- Registration from December 1st till January 13th 2025 through our website:

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee of **25€** (50€ on site) per athlete must be paid. For the Judo Open Women: 40€ to fight in Juniors and Seniors.

Only payments by bank transfer will be effective and valid. If a Judoka cannot take part in the tournament, no money will be given back during the event. However, it is possible to get money back for each missing athlete <u>before the 10th of January</u>.

CONTROL OF ENTRIES AND ACCREDITATION

The control of entries and issuing of accreditation cards will take place at Hall Omnisport Visé for men & Hall Omnisport "La Préalle" (Herstal) for women.

- On 24th of January 2025 from 17:00 to 20:00
- On 25th of January 2025 from 16:00 to 18:00

At least one team official must attend in time to confirm the entries of all athletes and officials.

For coaches: one card for one team; second card free if six judokas on tatami.

Extra accreditation for delegation members will be charged at 30€ for two days.



WEIGH-IN

- Official weigh-in 24th of January 2025 from 17:00 to 20:00
- Official weigh-in 25th of January 2025 from 16:00 to 18:00

The weigh-in will be held in the Hall Omnisports Visé for Men and Hall Omnisport "La Préalle" Herstal for Women.

Herstal: The Friday weigh-in is valid for juniors taking part in the Seniors competition. But it is mandatory to confirm the participation during the Seniors weigh-in.

AGE

JUDO OPEN MEN: 15 years old and over (born in 2010 and before)

JUDO OPEN WOMEN: 15 years old and over (born in 2010 and before) and for Juniors (from 2005 to 2010)

Participation

There is no limit in the number of participations for each category for every federation.

Competition Rules

System of competition:

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF SOR, IJF Refereeing Rules and IJF Anti-Doping Rules. Especially refer to the New Uniform IJF

JUDO OPEN MEN: -64 participants: Doubles KO / +64 participants: Doubles repechage

JUDO OPEN WOMEN: Pool of 3-4 judokas followed by repechage bracket.

Weight categories:

Male: -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, +100kg

Female: -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, -78kg, +78kg

Duration of contest:

Four (4) minutes (real time); Golden Score – No time limit.

(May change if IJF regulations are amended.)

Each National Federation/club is responsible for its competitors (the control on non-pregnancy as well as the gender control are placed under their responsibility) and must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials, during the INTERNATIONAL BELGIAN JUDO OPEN.

ANTIDOPING

Doping control is possible according to the WADA regulations








6. OTHER INFORMATION

Judogi Control

- Judogi Control: a Judogi control will be operated according to the IJF rules prior to the fight. White and Blue Judogi are MANDATORY.
- Backnumber is recommended but not mandatory.

AWARDING CEREMONY

The organizer shall provide for the podium ceremony: Medals, gifts and prize money. (no prize money for juniors).

The competitors wearing their white judogi (no shoes, flip flops or socks) will stand on the podium according to the following order 2,1,3,3. Every competitor having won a medal has to attend the ceremony to receive their medal in person. If a competitor is absent during the awarding ceremony for no valid reason, he/she will lose the right to have the medal. It is strictly forbidden for competitors on the podium to bring national flags or similar identification other than the one represented in the regular manner on their equipment. Any demonstration of religious, political, personal or commercial sign is prohibited and so is wearing a cap or any other head cover.

FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES

All National Federations, officials, coaches and athletes participating in the INTERNATIONAL BELGIAN JUDO OPEN have to respect and accept the authority of the officials, the Statues, the Sport and Organization Rules, the Refereeing Rules of the IJF, as well as the IJF Antidoping Rules. According to the IJF Rules and SOR Provisions (point 23.8), individuals deemed to have acted against the IJF, its principles or purposes shall be subject to suspension or expulsion from the event and/or cancellation of their accreditation cards.

IMAGE OF ATHLETES

The federations/clubs are responsible to have obtained the rights for the Judo Wallonie Bruxelles (JWB) to use competitor's image in whichever way it considers it necessary for promotion of the sports.

Neither the organizer of the event, nor JWB (nor any of its officials or members) will be liable or responsible for any personal injury nor for any loss or damage to your property arising out of your participation and travelling in connection with these events.

Consent for Photography/Videos/filming

Delegates inscribed by their National Federations or clubs for JWB events consent to the JWB and its media partners to use content of them, including data, live results, photographs and/or video recordings (hereafter referred to as Media). Media could be used in print and digital medial formats including print publications, websites, emarketing, posters banners, advertising, film, broadcast, social media, education purposes and other purposes. The National Federation or club must ensure that they have the permission of each delegate or in the case of a minor the permission of the parent/guardian.
